The lid of the Card Case retains the original vibrant gilt coating whilst the body of the case is lined with a red material lining making this a very unusual example. On the front of the case there is a blank shield shaped cartouche which could be used to personalise this exceptional Silver Card Case. The Card Case lid flips open to hold your business or credit cards and the case is of a size that can still be used today with modern business / credit cards. The lid closes tightly, the hinge is in good condition and there are very few signs of use or wear despite this being 115 years old.
