Makuzu seal mark for 1905 . Condition . Perfect . Makuzu Kozan (Japan 1842 - 1916) was created "Imperial Master" by the Meiji Emperor in 1896 . He is considered one of the most important artist`s of the Meiji period , His work can be found in most Western museums and there are a number of vases in the splendid KHALILI Collection of Japanese Art .
