Wonderful small size 18th century Georgian "country made" mahogany chest of drawers. Only 2 foot 7" wide max. Two over three drawer configuration. The drawers with cock beading and an inlaid boxwood line and brass swan neck handles. The drawers are oak lined with pine bottoms, original steel locks and period brass swan neck handles. The chest stands on its original bracket feet. Nice 18th century mouldings to the top and bottom. The chest is in pretty good condition for its age and is a lovely colour with original patination. There are some old stains to the top but this does not detract from the colour. The brass swan neck handles are period handles and are in the original holes but they are not original, if you look really closely you can see it has had wooden knobs at some point in the past.
