Description

Gents antique silver wrist watch, 1918. The watch has a hand-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch measures 32.5mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the hinged case back for London (import mark), 1918, with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The case is in good condition, as is the watch glass. The dial has a charming appearance with concentric circles to the inner section, blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track. There is a little age related darkening but overall it is in very nice condition. A new leather strap has been fitted. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. Free worldwide shipping
