This is an antique partner's desk by John Taylor and Son, Edinburgh. A Victorian, Scottish desk with ecclesiastical gothic overtones. An oak desk dating to circa 1870. John Taylor & Son were synonymous with high quality furniture being appointed 'Cabinet-makers and Upholsterers in Ordinary to Her Majesty the Queen' in 1852. Superb build quality as one would expect from a John Taylor piece In Scottish blonde oak with a wax polished finish Grain interest displaying wisps of medullary rays Pugin-esque gothic and ecclesiastical overtones Blind tooled, claret, triple set skiver work surface Run of three frieze solid oak drawers Twin, double sided pedestal cabinets with field panel doors Dressed with quality shaped brass furniture Generous kneehole decorated with pierced brackets Quality, four lever, brass locks present, key absent Cabinets open on quality brass hinging A shelf one side with a bank of inner drawers opposite Each crafted in solid oak with well executed recessed pulls Hidden castors beneath continuous plinth pedestals A superior quality antique partner's desk from a renowned Victorian cabinet maker.
