An original late 19th century circa 1880 gilt bronze French mantle clock of high quality depicting a hunter with his game and fine hand painted sevre plaques ,the movement is stamped JBD (Jean Baptiste Delettrez) a very well known quality clock maker During the 19th century The clock has been recently serviced and keeping good time the clock has a 15 day duration that strikes upon a bell on the half hour and hour count , we can arrange shipping world wide please enquire for price .a little about his history below Delettrez and Achille Brocot, son of the respected clockmaker Louis-Gabriel Brocot, established the clockmaking company "Brocot et Delettrez" in Paris on 20 October 1851, with premises at 62 Rue Charlot.[1] Their speciality was a range of clocks based on the innovations of Brocot père and his other son Antoine, but generally of Achille's greatly advanced original design, some having a unique single-arm double-wheel escapement, some having a temperature-compensated pendulum, some having two dials, one of which showed the time and the other which showed a calendar and often other information such as phases of the moon, times of sunrise & sunset in Paris, etc.[2...

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
