The table has an arrangement of one long central drawer flanked by 2 pairs of graduated shorter drawers. All fitted with their original ornate brass handles. Standing on elegant cabriole legs with carved shell motifs to the knees. The matching upholstered stool has the same shell motifs to the knees and can be tucked away under the table when not in use.
