This is a rare colour way of silver hood and brown bakelite base. Superb mushroom shape enameled metal shade with copper accents and finial. Condition is excellent with minimal signs of age. Ideal for desks, center tables etc, beautiful ambient lighting. Bio Kathleen Eileen Moray Gray (9 August 1878–31 October 1976) was an Irish architect and furniture designer and a Pioneer of the Modern Movement in architecture. Gray died in 1976, at the age of 98, in Paris.
