This coincides with the makers mark engraved into the polished brass. The brass, leather on the binoculars and the leather case are all marked with the crow's foot war office mark. They have folding eye shades and build in sun shades to the lens. One of the finest pairs we have had and in excellent condition. The case measures 8 1/2" x 6" x 3 1/4" ; the binoculars measure 6 1/4" expanding to 8" when fully extended x 5" x 2 1/4". Dating to c.1916 / 1917.
