Description

A stunning quality mahogany and ormolu mounted French Empire daybed. Constructed using the finest flame mahogany, the shaped ends having ormolu mounted swan necks on the front and reverse. Newly re-upholstered in a quality patterned gold silk, with the finest quality mouldings and mounts raised on superb mahogany and bronze lions monopode supports. 2nd Empire in the style and manner of Georges Jacob Circa 1880. Dimensions: 74" wide x 28" deep x 34" high. Condition: This daybed is in stunning condition, newly reupholstered to a very high standard. Georges Jacob (1768-1803) worked very early with his father and his brother François from which would take over the business in 1796. François-Honoré-Georges (1770-1841) added the Desmaller patronym to his name. In 1803 with the death of his brother George II Jacob, a new company name was created which was called Jacob Desmaller & Co. During the second (2nd) French Empire Napoleon III requested many designs and 'Styles' be recreated. The designs from the first French Empire such as original period furniture by master cabinet makers like Jacob were copied and reproduced.

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
