Edwardian inlaid writing table This Edwardian inlaid writing table was made circa 1900. The desk stands on square tapering legs with brown porcelain wheel rolling castors. It is fitted with 2 drawers each side of the wide centre drawer, that is above the arched kneehole. The top has an inset red leather writing surface with gilt tooling around the edge. To the rear of this are 3 small drawers inlaid with swag decoration and the original brass knob pull handles. A pierced cast brass gallery mounted to the rear finishes the desk to give it the classic Edwardian style. The writing desk is profusely inlaid on the drawer fronts with bell flowers, scroll, and leaf designs. The art of cross-banding is also used around the top and drawer edges. This Edwardian writing table is unique to us and cannot be purchased elsewhere.
