Description

A 1920s Lip pocket watch. The watch has a stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch measures 51.5mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The nickel coloured case is stamped as being Silvernus which was a copper and nickel alloy. Case makers gave the alloy their own names such as Silveroid and Silverine. Silvernus was a name used by Thomas Russell which suggests that this movement and case did not originally start life together. There is a little unevenness to the back of the watch but overall the case is in good condition for a 1920s piece. The acrylic lens is in good condition. The signed dial is in super condition and the shaped dial hands are a handsome feature. There is also a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track with 24 hour dial.
