Description

Circa 1910-1930 this very unusual chandelier still has the original long crystal glass drops from that period. It measures 53cm from the fitting at the top to the very bottom of the longest drop and approximately 30cm square around the sides. It has been rewired to UK specifications and has a single light taking a standard bayonet sized light bulb. The metal details could have been silver plated, or painted in a silver paint, and around the middle is an ornate 'fan' decoration on each side - see photo 1- all untouched and original. At each corner are raised angular glass decorative shapes and each holds a detailed large drop - see photo 2 with swags of glass drops between each corner. It has proved difficult to photograph because the light bounces around the crystal drops causing everything to look discoloured; in real life it is fresh and sparkling to look at. The long drops are all original, some are slightly different to others with small signs of damage on a few, but they make a lovely sound when moved. We have left them because we prefer to sell original items, but they can be replaced with new crystal drops to give more uniformity - these can be sourced online...
