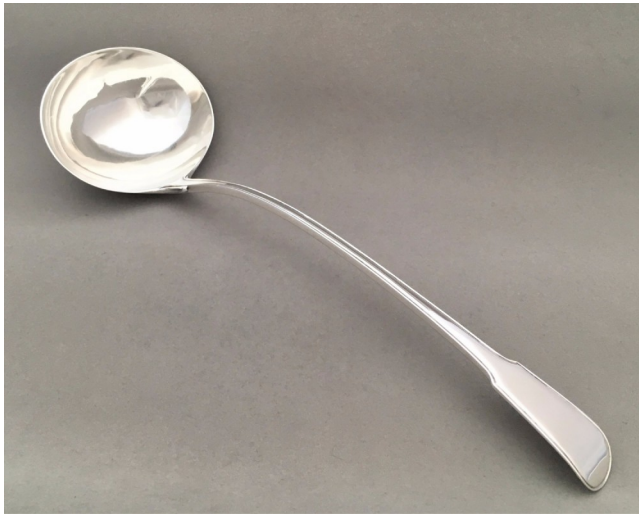

A rare 18th Century silver Fiddle & Thread soup ladle. This fine example is at the beginning of the sought after Fiddle & Thread pattern and is double struck (pattern front and back). This pattern began with a single line of thread, to be replaced in the 19th Century with a double line of thread. The particular example is of the early single line of thread and has the rare combination of the 'teardrop fall' design above the hallmarks on the reverse top of the shank.
