The Earl of Barrymore and his two brothers, three of the wildest rakes of the day, whose follies were so notorious and extravagant, that they received the popular nicknames of Newgate, Hellgate, and Cripplegate. They had a sister, to whom the Prince of Wales gave the nickname of Billingsgate." This wonderful print has been re-framed in a fine quality Hogarth frame, a real collectors piece.
