The drop leaves are supported when in use by wings that swing out from the side of the table. The top has fine box wood stringing as well as a central inlaid panel as well as panels on each leaf. The table stands on square tapering legs to each corner, finishing on the original brass square caps with brass castors under. The legs are joined by a platform shelf that has a pierced gallery and fine box stringing. There is one long drawer to the front again with its original brassware.
