A rare George III silver 'Kyan' (or cayenne) condiment Label. This wonderful piece is rectangular in shape with a reeded border. The word Kyan is pierced to the centre. The label is supported on a belcher chain and to the reverse is the maker's mark. Cayenne pepper was served in powdered form at the table among a number of other condiments rarely used in this way today. The unusual spelling makes this a rare find. Dimensions below.
