Description

Gents antique silver trench watch, 1915. The watch has a hand-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch measures 33mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the hinged case back for London 1915 with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The case has a couple of small indentations and some unevenness to the back. The watch glass has small marks, barely noticeable to the naked eye. The enamel dial is in good condition. A new leather strap has been fitted. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. Free worldwide shipping
