Description

Early 19th.c. Regency era specimen top centre table c.1820. Remarkable 41" diameter table top featuring a symmetrically arranged flame mahogany centre and rosewood crossbanded edge, between which are laid scores of specimen veneers. Amongst the timbers used here we have identified pieces of cherry, ash, oak, elm, bird's eye maple, birch, yew, English walnut, larch and chestnut. On solid mahogany ground work. Raised on a simple turned mahogany column and square plinth. With four swept legs with brass paw feet and castors. Table top can be tipped to vertical when not in use or removed for ease of delivery. Some obvious old wear to the top. Otherwise very good condition, solid and sturdy with the original brass catch. Attractive mellow honey colour, faded with age, cleaned and polished in our workshops. Dimensions: width 41", depth 41", height 31".
