A rare George III silver anchovy condiment Label. This wonderful piece is rectangular in shape with a reeded border and clipped corners. The word anchovy is engraved to the centre. The label is supported on a belcher chain and to the reverse is the maker's mark. Anchovy sauce was served at the table, among a number of other condiments rarely used in this way today.
