A truly superb solid silver Vesta Case. The pattern is a stunning engine turned design with an empty cartouch in the centre on the front of the case. The design is unusual as it is seamless all around the case. The lid is hinged to one side and when opened reveals a very pleasing golden gilded finish to the interior. There is a loop for attachment. Very clear hallmarks are visible on the inside lip of the Vesta case and also to the inside of the lid for the Chester Assay Office with a date mark for 1912 and maker's marks for the renowned maker Sampson Mordan.

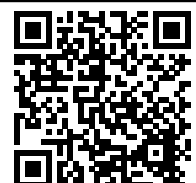
