There is a single long drawer to the freeze, fitted with art nouveau influenced solid copper handles. The turned column supports are reeded and terminate in squat cabriole legs with ball and claw feet. Offered for sale in excellent original condition, ready to go straight into the home. Dimensions: Width 108cms Depth 48cms Height 115cms Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business skills, John B. Maple took over the company while still a young man. By the 1880s they were the largest furniture store in the world, exported their fine furniture to every continent. Maples manufactured their luxury furniture entirely in-house, at a huge modern complex. A timber importer and furniture exporter, they landed prestigious contracts furnis...

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
