A superb early Victorian solid silver Stilton scoop. Wonderful heavy gauge silver, the scoop has a beautifully decorated handle in an iconic Victorian style. The top of the handle bears an initial 'B' very slightly engraved. Hallmarks are clearly visible on both the handle and on the back of the Scoop for the Sheffield Assay Office with a date mark for 1852 along with the Lion Passant indicating the finest sterling silver and maker's mark for the silversmith Aaron Hadfield. The craftsmanship of the silversmith is evident - a superb item, wonderful gift or for a collector of the finest cutlery. Lovely heavy weight - nice to hold in the hand.
