An antique 1889 silver Waltham pocket watch, originally retailed by Fattorini & Sons Bradford. The watch has a key-wound movement which is working nicely. (A winding key is included)The movement is the Am.W.Co grade and the serial number 5458372 tells us that it was made between August 1892 and October 1892. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. The watch measures 55.4mm diameter excluding the stem and the loop. The case is silver and has Birmingham hallmarks for 1897 with a maker's mark for Alfred Bedford, the manager of the London branch of Waltham. . The case has light surface marking from use and some wear to the engine turned detail on the back but overall it is in nice condition for an 1890s piece. The glass lens is in nice condition. The enamel dial is signed with the retailers name Fattorini & Sons, Bradford, Watch & Chronometer manufacturers. The chapter ring has several faint hairline cracks although hardly noticeable but otherwise it is in nice condition. The watch has gold hands and a blued steel sub seconds hand. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. Price includes worldwide postage
