The case and dial are both marked with the broad arrow, signifying this watch was issued by the MOD. A stainless steel case with stepped edges. A 15 jewel manual wind caliber 12.68Z mechanism signed Longines. These watches are often incorrectly described as a 'Greenlander', based on the fact they were thought to have been taken on the British North Greenland Expeditions of 1952-54. The production run of these watches is estimated to be around 8000. Circa 1945. Case width 38mm.
