Description

This fabulous VICTORIAN MAJOLICA CHEESE DOME AND STAND, bearing the marks of GEORGE JONES from Stoke-on-Trent, dates from circa 1880. It has a wonderful COW knop, rope-twist edging, very well-defined foliage decoration and beautiful liquid glazes, all typically GEORGE JONES. The DOME is in good condition with just the tips of the cow's horns missing and the head of the cow reglued and repainted at the neck. The STAND has old restoration to the edges. It appears there are three main areas where chips of the original pottery have been reglued and painted over. These areas are indicated by the red dots. If you look at the top of the stand, carefully, there does not seem to be many areas of replacement pottery, it mainly seems to be overpainting. The centre of the Stand is in good condition and has not been restored. Height: 9 inches (23 cm) Diameter of Stand: 12 inches (30.5 cm)
