Description

A fine early 18th century chest of drawers, the chest is made from oak and is of heavy construction. The boarded top has a thick molding run front and sides overhanging three drawers each with deeply molded frames, the drawers separated by rounded moldings. To the bottom there is a heavy molded skirt running front and sides that is fixed to the stiles. To the sides, there is plain dual panels with molded borders. The drawer fronts have later brass handles but still has the original locks and escutcheons. The chest has had some wood worm in the past and a few old repairs commiserate with age but has fantastic colour and is in excellent condition.
