A very fine quality display or china cabinet by the renowned firm of Maple & Co. Made from solid Cuban mahogany with inlaid satinwood cross banding and box line stringing. The 3 opening doors are air tight, a sign of the quality and a trade mark of Maple & Co. Inside are fixed shelves for displaying china or curios. The edges of the shelves are even inlaid. The central door is bevelled glass, again a sign of the quality and she sits on 4 out swept legs. You don't often see a piece of furniture made to such a high level of craftsmanship by one of the top London firms in the Edwardian era. Although not marked Maple & Co this is one of their models that they sold, some of their furniture was marked and some not, this model is shown in the brochure of the period.
