Description

This is a rather handsome mahogany cabinet which is really most unusual and flexible. We don't know what its original function was but it has a lifting lid, a bit like the old record players of the early 1900s but this one has a polished surface which is excellent for serving perhaps. The inside has movable shelves behind the opening doors that have a superb graining in burr maple. The bottom section, looking like a drawer drops to receive papers or files etc. This was originally sectioned but has now been made open. Uses are numerous, a server in a dining room where everything from plates to napkins etc can be stored. In a bathroom great for towels and other items. It could be really useful in a restaurant for taking orders and storage of menus, cutlery, condiments etc. It is in great condition with good colour and as stated excellent graining, and of course the Chippendale style blind fret around the top, everything sitting on rather neat bracket feet.
