Beautiful example of an antique Windsor lathe-back country chair – sometimes referred to as a grandfather chair. It dates from the late 1800s. The frame is made in beech with a solid elm seat. The turned legs are united by an H-stretcher and the gently arched top rail has elegant serpentine-curved lathes beneath, with scrolling elm arms supported by turned spindles. It has a beautiful finish with a rich colour and patina and the back of the seat is stamped 'G' by the maker. The chair stands approximately 42" (107cm) high, the seat is 19 1/2" (50cm) deep and arm to arm the chair is 25" (64cm) wide. It is in good condition and is strong and sturdy with no signs of worm or any major damages.
