In good condition with some shrinkage to the gesso commensurate with age (see photos). Some foxing to original glass plate. Provenance: Inscription to reverse 'Dean, Haughton Hall, Bunbury, Cheshire'. Believed to have been once part of the furnishings of Geoffrey & Joyce Dean of Haughton Hall, Cheshire before the Hall was re-developed. Dimensions: Width 28 1/4" (71.7cm) at widest point.
