The marble original of the goddess of love and beauty is attributed to the Greek sculptor Alexandria of Antioch. The base with an indistinct undeciphered Foundry signature to the side of the base. Good consistent rich patina, with clear cast details. Signed to rear edge by the foundry in indeciphered script. H 19" W 5" D 4" France or Italy c. 1880
