A couple of minor old moulding repairs otherwise very good. Nice to get a pair of this neat size. This pair of cabinets is much earlier than the usual marquetry inlaid burr walnut furniture, could even be touching the William IV period. One bears a label under the marble top for the property of MARCHIONESS ANGLESEY SIZE; 22 1/2" wide by 16" deep by 36" high CIRCA; 1850 - 1860
