A splendid quality late Victorian period inlaid rosewood chiffonier, or parlour cabinet. Of excellent construction with attractive rosewood veneers onto a mahogany frame, by the renowned firm Maple and Co of London. The upper section fitted with its original beveled plate mirrors (some very minor foxing) with a canopy supported by elegant turned mahogany columns. The base section with a pair of convex cupboard doors to the ends (lockable with keys supplied) and two small drawers to the centre. The whole piece decorated throughout with profuse marquetry inlay in satinwood, boxwood, mother of pearl and ivory. Cleaned and waxed in our workshops, it has an excellent colour and patina. This is a really impressive chiffonier from a world class maker of furniture, offered for sale in excellent condition, ready to go straight into the home. Splits into 2 sections for ease of installation. Dimensions: Width 142cms Depth 47cms Height 222cms. Maple & Co was established by John Maple, a shopkeeper from Horley, Surrey, who later opened a furniture shop in Tottenham Court Road. However it was his son, John Blundell Maple, who made Maples & Co a success. With exceptional business...
