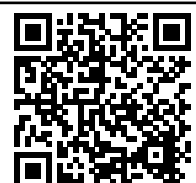

The oval base stands on four ball feet, with space for eight slices of toast. The handle is looped with a charming half moon shaped aperture and finished with a wonderful armorial. There are some signs that a couple of the supports have been re-soldered to the base for strength, which is very common with this type of Georgian wirework and is commensurate with age and use.
