'SHAKESPEARE' engraved by Georg Vertue, for the frontispiece of Alexander Pope's Collected Works of Shakespeare of 1725, after the original portrait miniature of Shakespeare in Edward Harley, 2nd Earl of Oxford's collection. The plate titled 'SHAKESPEARE, ob. an. 1616. Aetat. 53' visible plate size 20cm x 15cm, framed size 25cm x 19cm. 'Sr. Thomas Browne, Kt. M.D.' engraved by M.V. dr Guchs, late 17th/early 18th century. Visible plate size 17.25cm x 14cm, framed size 22cm x 18cm. Sir Francis Bacon, late 17th/early 18th century, titled: 'Hono Francifeus Bacon. Baro de Verulam Vice County St. Albani, mortis 9 Aprilis A. 1626. Anno Etatis fuae 66. Visible plate size 17.25cm x 14cm, framed size 22cm x 18cm.
