Truly the creme de la creme of scent bottle boxes, made from exotic Rosewood and bound with top notch cast brass fittings with quality screwed construction. This English gem dates to the William IV era, around 1830 and typical of the period. The interior is quite amazing with six hand cut crystal perfume bottles or decanters, all in near mint condition, I can only surmise that this box was hardly or never used. The bottles are without chips or cracks and the stoppers are also without damage. The interior of the lid is lined in deep green velvet with tufting, very typical of the William IV period. The bottles fit perfectly in the green leather lined compartments. Quite sensational, heirloom quality in superb condition (alas, no key).
