Description

Antique Masonic silver Marvin trench watch, 1915. The watch has a Swiss hand-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch itself measures 32mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the hinged case back for London (import mark) 1915 with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The case is in good condition. The winding crown is a later replacement. The watch glass is in good condition too. The dial has the Masonic compass and square logo, Breguet style blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. A new leather strap has been fitted.
