The lower section has a wonderful fitted secretaire interior with drawers, pigeon holes and a central compartment which slides out via a concealed button to reveal an arrangement of secret drawers, with the finest mahogany dovetails and fitting absolutely perfectly almost creating a vacuum, such is the quality of the craftsmanship. Also with a further four oak lined drawers again with flame mahogany fronts and typical Gillows oval handles. Supported on slender splayed bracket feet.
