It is beautifully made of ormolu (fine gilded brass/bronze), finely modelled and chased, and mounted with exquisite Sevres style porcelain. The ormolu is in stunning, untouched, original condition. Porcelain has a blue ground and is delicately painted with a delightful scene of a gentleman and ladies seated in a country setting. The dial has a tranquil scene of a house by a lake and the urn is decorated with the finest flowers and a butterfly. Delicate 'jewel' are applied as half hour markers between the lettering and the urn has white 'jewels' around the painted panel. The French movement is of very high quality as one would expect of Japy Freres. It has the Japy Freres 'Grande Medaille d'Honneur' mark on the movement backplate. It is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully serviced by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original. It runs for 8 days on one wind and strikes the hours and halves on a bell.
