Description

A scarcely seen piece of English Boulle, a spectacular large Tobacco box with cover dating to the Victorian period, around 1880. This is a heavy, solid piece, lovely quality and exceptional condition. The panels that run around the side are two panels of polished cut brass in Tortoiseshell and the others with the reverse of shell in brass. The box is made from solid Rosewood and the interior lined with the original lead lining. This was gifted at a later date as there is a later solid sterling silver shield mount to the underside of the lid, engraved "Clay Bird Shooting Won by H. Luff 1924"; the silver is fully hallmarked for London 1924 together with the makers mark for Robert Pringle. A highly sought-after piece in excellent condition measuring 5 3/4" in diameter x 7" tall.
