Description

A superb oak chest of drawers dating from the late 17th Century. They have nice small proportions and are made of solid oak with panelled sides and three long drawers. They have engraved brass plate handles and matching escutcheons which, although put on later, have been on the chest of drawers a considerable time. The drawers were made to run on 'side runners' - a sign of their age. The top drawer still uses its side runner but the bottom two have now been made to run on bottom runners. They are an excellent quality set and have been well looked after over the years. The chest is strong and sturdy with a good solid back. They have developed a wonderful rich aged patina and have picked up various small knocks, marks and signs of age and use but nothing detrimental. There are various small repairs and restorations and it is believed that the drawer fronts would have likely had mouldings to match the panelled sides but they certainly display beautifully.
