Description

1932 silver Pinnacle pocket watch and silver chain. The watch has a signed Swiss stem-winding movement which is working well. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and has Birmingham hallmarks for 1932 with the makers mark for the Dennison Watch Case Company, a prolific case manufacturer who supplied various watch makers. The case is in nice condition with only light surface marking from use. The back of the watch has monogrammed initials. The watch lens is acrylic and is in nice condition. The signed dial has its original blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track. There are a couple of very faint hairline cracks between 4 and 5 o'clock but otherwise the dial is in nice condition. The watch comes with a single silver chain, 36cm long including the T-bar and the clasp, and also an unusual fob which has a requisite in the back, probably originally for hair.
