Cabinetmakers at the start of the 20thc would use redundant timber from Georgian pieces to construct these superb dining tables. Hence all the timber is not all the same, which adds to its individuality. The top has a good wide crossbanding that is bordered with ebony stringing. This table consists of a twin pillar base with beautifully turned gun barrel columns. The 3 splay legs coming off the column with brass claw toes with rolling castors below. The table can be used with or without the one leaf set in place, and you could seat 10 around this table. Imagine entertaining your family and friends around this dining table, and the admiring comments you will receive about the beauty and feel of this individual piece.
