A stunning cut glass bonbonniere from the Regency period. This rare piece has a goblet shaped body with extensive hobnail cutting and fan cutting to the rim. This design is continued on the lid, where there is a star cut finial. A sign of high quality is that the cutting extends right across the base area echoing the finial with a fabulous cut star.
