Description

This unusual VICTORIAN MAJOLICA MONKEY WALL POCKET dates from circa 1880. The MONKEY is holding a large COCONUT SHELL which would hold a small arrangement of flowers, foliage or small fruit. The pottery is marked to the bottom left corner with the impressed initials W & R within a diamond shaped lozenge. Opinion is divided as to whether this is the mark of the Longton, Staffordshire Potters Wayte and Ridge or the Firm of Wittman & Roth, Importers of London. Either way he looks impressive when hung on the wall. The condition is good. The bottom right corner of the tree bark has been reglued and overpainted. Height: 18 inches (46 cm)
