Description

Late C19th George III period mahogany drop-leaf Pembroke "Deception" table. Interesting Georgian mahogany Pembroke style drop-leaf table with concealed cupboard behind false drop-leaf. Probably designed as a bedside or chamber table in which to conceal a pot. The interior with a division. Attributed to Gillows of Lancaster from whom a design appears in the 'Gillow Estimate Sketch Books' for June /July 1787 (Westminster City Archives 94/44-5). A similar table is illustrated in "Gillow Furniture Designs 1760-1800" by Lindsay Boynton. Raised a tapering square section legs, fitted with all original lacquered brass-ware. (Key lacking). In excellent original condition with its original surface and skin. Superior grade of mahogany with has achieved a rich patina and colour. W 24" D (closed) 15" Leaves 9.5" H 28" England, probably Gillows of Lancaster c. 1790
