The border design is also typical for this village. The rug has a very light feel due to the large amount of ivory and olive brown used in the weaving. The rug is in excellent condition with fine weave and slight even wear and good pile. Both ends retain the original flat woven and plaited finishes. The rug is suitable for normal domestic use.
