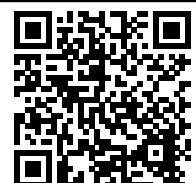
Description

Gents Omega wrist watch, circa 1947. The watch has a hand-winding movement, 30T2 PC, which is working nicely. The movement is fully signed and the serial number 11,121,495 dates it back to around 1947. The watch measures 33mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs. The case is stainless steel. The front and sides of the case are in good condition, the case back has some unevenness. The case, reference 13322, was made for Omega by the Dennison case company and is one of the most classic case designs that Dennison made for Omega. Dennison was a prolific maker of cases for various watch makers. The winding crown is probably a replacement but of the correct style. The lens is in good condition. The signed dial is in its original finish and has feuille shaped hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. There is marking to the dial as shown in the photos.
