## Description

Early 19th.c. North Wales oak cloak or tack cupboard c.1820. Designed to provide storage for clothing and riding gear which could be hung from the two rows of original peg hooks in the top. With two short and one long drawer in the base (the top two drawers are dummy fronts allowing extra hanging length inside). Moulded cornice over ogee arched door panels with moulded surround, quarter column detail to the front corners, diamond shaped bone escutcheon. Cockbeaded drawer fronts with large turned wooden knobs. Raised on shaped bracket feet. Oak panelled sides and deal back boards. Excellent colour and condition, cleaned and polished in our workshops. Key supplied. Could be easily fitted with a hanging rail if preferred or shelves to make a useful kitchen cabinet. Dimensions: width 52", depth 21", height 72".
